The Gypsy Council was founded on December 11th 1966 in the very same room that we will hold this jubilee meeting.

HOW TO GET THERE

Public transport. Take a train from London Bridge to St Mary Cray (trains every 30 minutes at ten past and twenty to the hour, journey time 41 minutes. Then either walk down the Station Approach, catch a 51 bus on Sevenoaks Way (the A224) get off at Homebase, walk through the Homebase Car Park, turn right on Main Road, and walk south till you come to the pub by St Paul's Cray Village Green. Alternatively walk North on Sevenoaks Way, turn right onto Leeson Hill/Station Road (the B258), then left at Main Road and walk north till you get to the Bull. The Bus save you about half the walk.

Driving: Leave the M25 at Junction 3, and take the A20 towards London. Turn left at the A224 (Sevenoaks Way) Then take the second turning left onto Main Road, and follow it south to the Bull Inn.
